- iii. Motion to pass the Amazon fundraising campaign by Zach Moloch seconded by Mitchell Morehead. Motion passed.

# f. Severe Storms and Doppler Radar Conference, March 26 – 28, 2015

- i. Agenda Team: Bill Gallus informed us we have a banquet speaker lined up. The speaker will be Karen Kosiba from the Center for Severe Weather Research. Ben McMillian and Tony Laubach have both been confirmed for storm chaser perspective of Pilger, NE tornadoes. Other speakers we hope to have are Gene Willers, Pilger Bank president who helped bank customers to safety for Pilger, NE tornadoes, Leigh Orf, Dan Neitfeld, and a Little Rock, Arkansas speaker on the Villonia tornado. Bill will contact these individuals immediately. At the moment: three confirmed speakers, seven invited speakers at about \$3500-\$3700. Last year about \$4500 for invited speakers.
